

## Fixed Faux Columns

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This technique works only with CSS Sculptor layouts that have a fixed (pixel-based) width.

1. Open CSS Sculptor
2. Choose a preset layout you want to work with from the Layout list.
3. Make any changes to the layout you want.  
Select a Design like Moab from the list
4. Click the **Preview** area.
5. When your primary browser opens, expand the window to see the full width of the layout.
6. Use a screen capture utility to grab the screen. With PCs, press Alt+Prnt Scrn and with Macs, press Control-Command-Shift-3.
7. Open your graphics editor and paste the captured screen. Or if you used a screen capture utility, open the saved file.
8. Select a thin horizontal slice of the entire design. Your slice should be the same width as your layout and anywhere from 10 to 25 pixels high.  
The default width is 780 pixels
9. Copy the slice and paste it in a new document in your graphics program.
10. Remove any text that may appear in the slice so that only borders and backgrounds are showing.
11. Export your image in a Web friendly format (GIF, JPG or PNG) to your site.
12. In CSS Sculptor, click the **Design** tab.
13. In the Layout Components tree, choose **contentWrapper**.
14. In the Background & Border area, choose the **Image Source** subtab.



15. Click the **folder icon** and locate your saved graphic image.
16. Click the **Image Repeat and Attachement** subtab.
17. From the Repeat list, choose **repeat-y**.
18. Click the **Output** tab.
19. If you want to change the existing preset layout, choose **Overwrite Existing Preset** in the Presets area, If you want to create a new preset, choose **Create new preset** and enter a name for your new larger font size layout.
