

## Setting up your Access database to work with an iRite text editor

---

In order for your iRite text editor to work effectively, you must make sure that your database is properly configured to store the data that is outputted from the editor.

### What Do You Need to Start?

- Dreamweaver CS3 or 8
- iRite v1.0 or higher
- DataAssist v2.0 or higher
- Dreamweaver dynamic site (ASP-JS, ASP-VB, ColdFusion or PHP)
- Datasources file located in your Order History

### Setting up your Access Database

The following steps show you how to configure your Microsoft Access database to work with an iRite text area.

1. Open the **event\_registration.mdb** file that you obtained from your Order History.
2. Click **Open** when the Security Warning displays.
3. In Microsoft Access, click once to select the **presentations table**.
4. Click on the **Design** button.
5. Click in the **Data Type** field for the **PresentDescFull** Field Name.
6. Select **Memo** from the data type menu list.
7. From the File option in the Menu bar, select **Save**.
8. **Close** Microsoft Access.
