

Setting up your Microsoft SQL Server database to work with an iRite text editor

In order for your iRite text editor to work effectively, you must make sure that your database is properly configured to store the data that is outputted from the editor.

What Do You Need to Start?

- Dreamweaver CS3 or 8
- iRite v1.0 or higher
- DataAssist v2.0 or higher
- Dreamweaver dynamic site (ASP-JS, ASP-VB, ColdFusion or PHP)
- Datasources file located in your Order History

Setting up your Microsoft SQL Server Database

The following steps show you how to configure your Microsoft SQL Server database to work with an iRite text area.

1. Open the SQL **Server Enterprise Manager**.
2. Expand the **Databases** folder.
3. Click once on the **event_registration** database.
4. Double-click on the **Tables** icon.
5. Click once on the **Presentations table**.
6. From the Action option in the menu bar, select **Design Table**.
7. Click once in the **Datatype** cell for **PresentDescFull**.
8. Select **ntext** from the menu list.
9. **Close** this window.
10. Click **Yes** to save your changes.
1. **Close** the SQL Server Enterprise Manager.
