

Setting up your MySQL database to work with an iRite text editor

In order for your iRite text editor to work effectively, you must make sure that your database is properly configured to store the data that is outputted from the editor.

What Do You Need to Start?

- Dreamweaver CS3 or 8
- iRite v1.0 or higher
- DataAssist v2.0 or higher
- Dreamweaver dynamic site (ASP-JS, ASP-VB, ColdFusion or PHP)
- Datasources file located in your Order History

Setting up your MySQL Database

The following steps show you how to configure your MySQL database to work with an iRite text area.

1. Open the **MySQL Administrator** and connect to your server.
2. Click on **Catalogs**.
3. Select the **event_registration** database that you obtained from your Order History.
4. Double-click on the **presentations** table.
5. Double-click in the **Datatype** cell for **PresentDescFull**.
6. Enter **TEXT** in this cell.
7. Click **Apply Changes**.
8. Click **Execute**.
1. **Close** the MySQL Administrator.
